AUTISM ASSESSMENT

Step 1:

Initial consultation with the Psychologist (approx. 1 hr)

Step 2:

Clinical questionnaires sent to the parent/s and school teacher (\$25 per questionnaire)

This may also include an assessment and diagnosis of the child's adaptive behaviour as this is often needed for NDIS applications or education QLD assistance.

Step 3:

School interview to gather information about your child within the school context (approx. 30 mins)

Step 4:

Child/adult attends with parent/s for testing using the Autism Diagnostic Observation Scale 2 or MIGDAS (Approx. 1.5 - 2 hrs)

Step 5:

Information analysed and a diagnostic report is written with recommendations for school or NDIS etc. (2 hrs)

Step 6:

Feedback session on findings with recommendations for the child/adult (1 hr)

ADHD ASSESSMENT

To establish if a child meets the diagnostic criteria for ADHD, the following process is taken.

Step 1:

Initial consultation to take detailed history of the child's development, physical and mental health, with careful consideration of other information such as previous records, prior school reports and family accounts and presenting concerns (approx. 1 hr).

Step 2:

Parents and a teacher, or someone else who knows the child well, are asked to complete online clinical diagnostic questionnaires. Self-report clinical questionnaire can be completed by the child if they are over the age of 10 years. (\$25 per assessment)

Step 3:

Formal structured interview using the Young Diva to assess for ADHD with Parent/Cargiver (approx. 1 hr)

Step 4:

The child may be required to complete psychometric testing to assess memory/cognitive ability/executive function. An IQ assessment or tests of memory and attention can compare their performance to their peer group.

Step 5:

Diagnostic report is written (approx. 2.5 - 5 hrs, depending on level of testing completed)

Step 6:

Feedback session with parents. (approx. 1 hr)
